The History of Hybrids From Branemark to Photogrammetry

Objectives:

1. The full-arch implant supported fixed detachable prosthesis, commonly known as a hybrid, has been the best solution for the restoration of the edentulous arch. The techniques, materials and protocols for fabricating hybrids have been changing very rapidly, especially with the introduction of intraoral scanning, 3D printing and photogrammetry technologies. From the traditional processed denture acrylic on a cast metal bar to the latest digital workflows, the foundational rules of prosthetic design have always remained the same. A knowledge of these foundational principles along with an understanding of when and how to apply new technologies can make treatment outcomes more predictable and ultimately more affordable to patients. This lecture will cover the past, present and exciting future of the hybrid prosthesis.
